Unfortunately, due to the current Corona regulations, it is not possible for Lewis to travel to Germany and hold the seminar in Dortmund.

As announced, Richard van Berkum* is therefore taking over as the sensei of the seminar.



*Richard van Berkum (4th Dan Aikikai) started training Aikido in 1996 and switched to Takemusu Aikido in 2000. From 2007 to 2013 he trained and taught with Lewis Bernaldo de Quirós (6th Dan Aikikai) in Zutphen. In 2013 he took over the dojo in Zutphen from Lewis, after he had moved to Spain, and has been teaching there ever since. In 2014 Richard received the 4th Dan Aikikai from Lewis Bernaldo de Quirós.

Due to the COVID pandemic we have decided to offer the seminar as a pure bukiwaza seminar. If the weather conditions allow it, we will train outside on the school yard in front of our gym. Furthermore, the number of places is limited to 24 persons. The hall doors will stay open - so pack warm socks ;-).
